



2017-2018 Fast Facts for Eagle County Airport

- 4 major airlines: Air Canada, American, Delta, and United
- 14 non-stop markets: Atlanta, Chicago, Dallas/Ft. Worth, Denver, Houston, Los Angeles, Miami, Newark, New York/Kennedy, Phoenix, Salt Lake City, San Francisco, Toronto and Washington Dulles
- 15 daily flights with up to 10 additional flights on weekends

New and expanded service for 2017-2018:

- New weekend non-stop flights from San Francisco on United, flights operate every Saturday and Sunday December 23-January 7, and February 17-March 25 and Saturdays only January 13-February 10
- New daily non-stop flights from Salt Lake City on Delta Air Lines, December 21-January 7
- More non-stop flights from Phoenix on American Airlines with daily service December 15-January 8, and February 15-April 2, and flights Thursday through Monday, January 11-February 11
- Additional flights from Chicago on United Airlines, daily service December 20-January 7 and February 15-April 1, and Saturday/Sunday flights January 13-February 11
- Additional flights from Chicago on American Airlines, 2nd daily flight December 15-January 7, Friday/Saturday flights January 12-March 31
- Continuation of Washington DC/Dulles Saturday flights on United Airlines December 23-March 31
- Additional Saturday flights from Atlanta on Delta Air Lines, December 23-January 6
- Additional Saturday flights from Newark on United Airlines, December 23-January 6 and February 17-March 3
- Air Canada Saturday service from Toronto will return February 3-March 31
- Increased capacity from Denver on United Airlines with two daily Airbus-320 aircraft in place of CRJ-700 regional jets for the entire season
- Dallas/Ft. Worth service is now daily year-round with no breaks in service this fall or next spring
